Parole Board Queensland – No Body No Parole Hearing

On 19 February 2020, Matthew Leslie Armitage was sentenced to 8 years imprisonment for the manslaughter of Shaun Barker.

Mr Armitage has applied for parole. Mr Barker's remains have not been located. Mr Armitage is a No Body No Parole prisoner.

On 26 August 2022 the Parole Board Queensland will meet to consider whether Mr Armitage has given satisfactory cooperation in the investigation of the homicide offence to identify the victim's location.

This matter will be heard at 10am on 26 August 2022 in Courtroom 34, Level 7, Brisbane Magistrates Court.

The Board's decision about whether the prisoner has given satisfactory cooperation will be published at a later date.
