Parole Board Queensland – No Body No Parole Hearing

On 10 February 2006 Clive Anthony Nicholson was sentenced to life imprisonment for the murder of his wife Julie Rose Nicholson.

Mr Nicholson has applied for parole. Mrs Nicholson's remains have not been located. Mr Nicholson is a No Body No Parole prisoner.

On Wednesday, 14 December 2022 the Parole Board Queensland will meet to consider whether Mr Nicholson has given satisfactory cooperation in the investigation of the homicide offence to identify the victim's location.

This matter will be heard not before 11am on 14 December 2022 in courtroom 17, level 4, Brisbane Magistrates Court.

The Board's decision about whether the prisoner has given satisfactory cooperation will be published at a later date.
