Parole Board Queensland – No Body-No Parole Decision

Pursuant to s 175C of the *Corrective Services Act 2006* Rodney Michael CHERRY is a No Body-No Parole prisoner.

The Parole Board Queensland (the Board) is required to consider whether Rodney Michael CHERRY has given satisfactory cooperation in the investigation of the homicide offence to identify his victim's location.

If the Board is not satisfied that Rodney Michael CHERRY has given satisfactory cooperation, it must make a no cooperation declaration about him.

If the Board makes a no cooperation declaration about a prisoner, the prisoner cannot apply for parole unless they are later given a notice that they have given satisfactory cooperation.

The Board's decision as to whether Rodney Michael CHERRY has given satisfactory cooperation in the investigation of the homicide offence to identify his victim's location will be published at approximately 2.00pm, on Tuesday 18th July 2023 at <https://www.pdq.qld.gov.au/no-body-no-parole/decisions-of-the-board>.
